MINUTES OF 16TH MEET [10. 06 2016]


1. Meeting began with a prayer by Fr Julius Kujin S.J.

8. The House decided to participate in the observance of Independence





Key theme for the Public Programme was decided tentatively focusing on the contribution of President Scientist Dr APJ Kalam.



UNIVERSITY RESULTS


- **College meets Village**



ACADEMIC AUDITING




