





MINUTES OF 20<sup>TH</sup> MEET HELD ON NOVEMBER 1, 2017.

## New Admissions

The criterion for selection to admission was on the basis of marks obtained in Graduation /Post Graduation and it was purely on merit basis as per the norms of National Council of Teacher Education.

## Induction Programme


