
Exhibition for ARCEIS students (iii) Organisation of National or International Seminar or Workshop, (iv) Alumni Meet and (v) Closing Ceremony



and closing ceremony.



- IBAC also resolved to have more advertisement for B.Ed programmes & also for M.A in education course.








## IQAC ANNUAL ACTION TAKEN REPORT:2018-19

### ADMISSIONS FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2018 – 2020

Admission process for the Academic Session 2018 – 2020 for the B.Ed Programme kept all of us busy from the month of March 15 to June 30, 2018. Keeping the qualifying percentage as per the norms of the National Council for Teacher Education, the criterion adopted for admission was purely on merit based on marks obtained by the applicants in their Graduation / Post Graduation examinations and the Entrance Test held on May 26, 2018 and of course by giving more opportunity to the students with the minority status. Though the approved Intake capacity of the college for B.Ed Course is of two units, this year too college admitted one unit comprising of 50 students. Hence we journeyed along the year 2018 – 2019 with, 08 regular and 04 part time faculty members, 105 students (50: 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester B.Ed; 50: 1<sup>st</sup> Semester B.ED and 5 in M.A.in Education Course) and 06 supporting staff.

### INDUCTION PROGRAMME

The academic session 2018 - 2019 began on July 17, with the Inaugural Holy Eucharist attended by all the students and staff and presided over by Rev. Fr Patrick Pradhan, S.J. the Superior of the Jesuit Community at Loyola. The Induction programme consisted of three days of orientation of the trainees. The entire Orientation Programme centred around Value orientation and enhancement of professional capacities animated by Fr Patrick Pradhan on “**Misconceptions about Counselling in Indian Scenario**”, S.J., Fr Francis A.V on “**IPP in Teacher Education in Sikkim**”, Dr Sebastian V.J on “**Influence of Attitude on Human Behaviour**”, Ms Julie Chettri on “**Multiple Intelligence in Teacher Education**”; Mr Sewan Rai on “**Significance of Fine Arts in Education**” and Fr Immanuel Henry, S.J, Loyola Alumnus on “**Role of Teacher in 21st Century.**” Ms Sinora Pradhan, Mrs Roshni Sharma and Dr Dona Rai conducted Ice breaking Sessions for the freshers. A “Book Fair” was organized by the college librarian for the new comers. The last day newly admitted B.Ed students were oriented on the culture of the institute and B.Ed Curriculum.

### UNIVERSITY RESULTS

B.Ed. results of the academic session 2016 - 2018 were declared by the Sikkim University on June 30, 2018. Once again Loyola College of Education, Namchi had achieved a hundred percent Pass result. The following Table 1.indicates their performance.

Its findings, report and recommendations had been submitted to the university. The college got renewal order and accordingly the admission for the same course has been already initiated.
